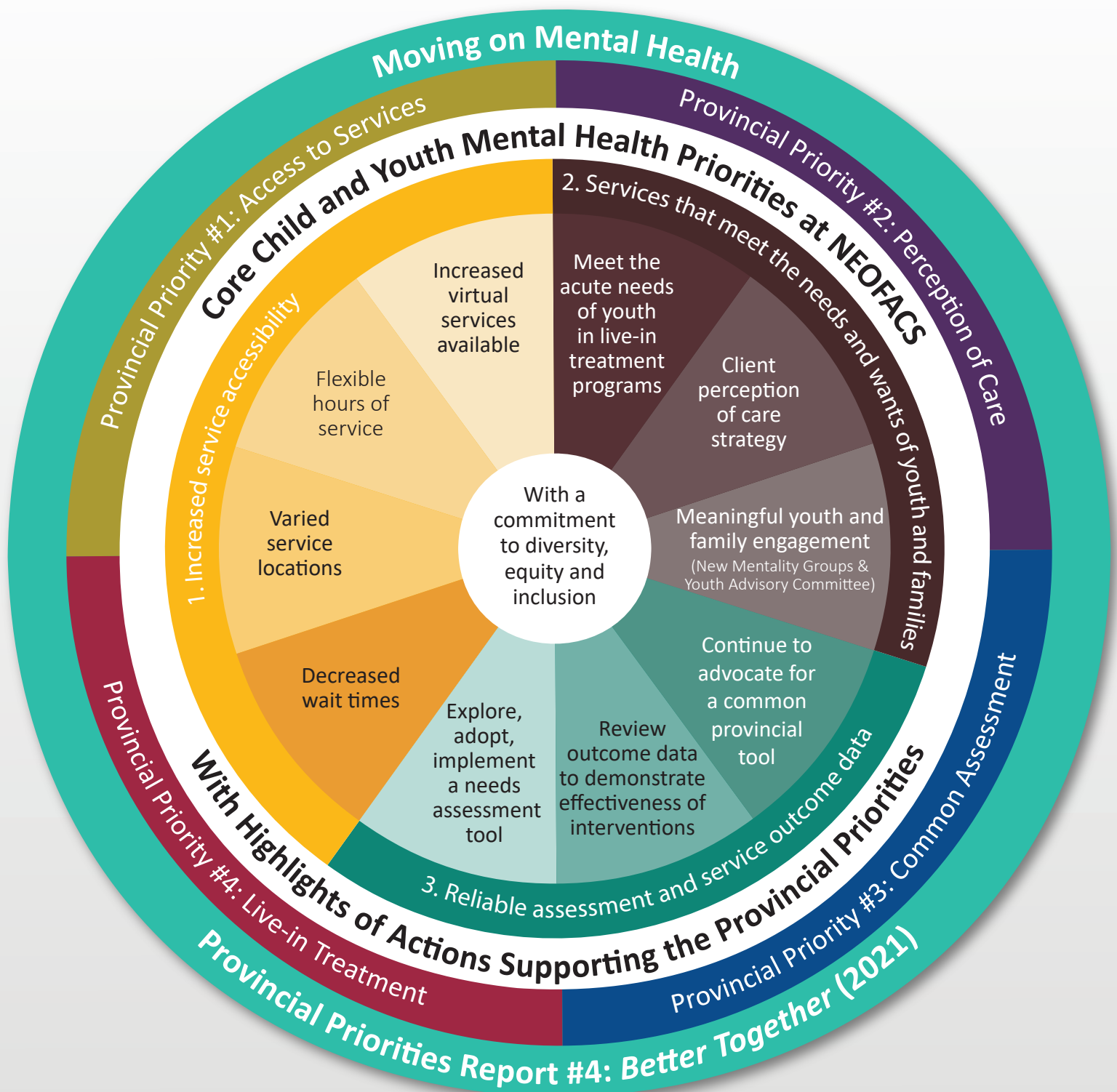


Cochrane-Timiskaming MOMH Priorities 2021-24

The Moving on Mental Health (MOMH) initiative in the Cochrane-Timiskaming area has outlined the following priorities which are grounded in the Child and Youth Mental Health Lead Agency Consortium (LAC) 2021 Provincial Priorities Report (PPR), *Better Together*.

The goal of the PPR is to analyze learnings and experience across the local service areas to identify and recommend action on the most critical barriers and opportunities in strengthening and transforming the child and youth mental health (CYMH) system.



As the Lead Agency providing Core CYMH Services, North Eastern Ontario Family and Children's Services (NEOFACS) works collaboratively with various community partners across the district to actively discuss and address broader community mental health priorities.

Community CYMH Priorities

- 1) Seamless transition between community and core CYMH services
- 2) Services and supports for Transition-aged youth (TAY)
- 3) Services and supports for youth with concurrent disorders
